Theophany - January 6



The final day of the Christmas season and one of the greatest feasts of the Eastern Church (celebrated since the second century) is Theophany or Yordan (or Epiphany). It commemorates the baptism of Christ in the river Jordan by St. John the Baptist when God appeared in the three Persons. As Jesus was standing in the water, the Holy Ghost in the appearance of a dove was seen above Him, while the voice of God the Father was heard to say, "This is my

beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased!"

On this day, it is the custom to bless water— a river, a lake, or the sea. or now in modern churches, a vessel of water — in a great ceremony including a procession with the carrying of banners and the cross. In Ukraine and sometimes in communities in the U.S. and Canada where Ukrainians had settled, this blessing of water was held outside at a local body of water such as a river or lake. The men of the community would build a large cross of ice blocks near where the water was blessed and dyed it red with beet kvas (a fermented beet juice). The incensing of the water by the priest signifies the descent of the Holy Ghost to Christ during His baptism. During the ceremony, three special candles are immersed in the water: this is to remind us that through Christ's baptism our sins are destroyed and forgiven. After the ceremony, the people take some of the blessed holy water to keep in their homes during the coming year.

The Blessing of the Home

It is the custom on Theophany/Yordan after the blessing of the water or in the days following this feast, for the priest to visit his parishioners at their home with holy water. In some areas, such as when distances visiting all the homes difficult, the head of the family may be the one who blesses the home.

Some are concerned that the home be tidied for this visit, for it would not be right to not have the home in order. But the real thing is that the family be there to welcome the blessing that the Priest brings. The priest is assisted by the oldest or the youngest member of the family through the house. While the Priest sprinkles the rooms with Holy Jordan water, he prays that the home is kept a place of love and security for the those that live there and that they be protected from evil of body and soul and be given abundantly of God's goodness, health, hope, and happiness, courage and confidence, and assurance of His lasting love and presence. This ceremony of the blessing of the home signifies the

This ceremony of the blessing of the home signifies the new beginning of both the new year and of baptism when the soul is cleansed.
