God bless each and every one that contributed in any way to our successful Centenary celebrations! Whether you helped with the preparations or made it happen 'the day' of the many special events or whether you came out to participate in the events - it was because of you that each of the events became a moment of grace where our Lord was able to speak to us and our guests and inspire us! The first day of the "Celebration Weekend" had us honouring the Lord in the Holy Eucharist with a Divine Liturgy and a 'retro' procession with the Blessed Sacrament during which we asked the Lord to bless the whole world from our parish as we thank Him for a 100 years of His blessings to us. On the 2nd day, we hosted all the clergy from across Manitoba at our Parish and then in the evening we also meditated on the awesomeness of the Holy Eucharist and our relationship to the Lord through this great gift. We also heard witnesses from Sister Oresta Svorak, SSMI, about how the Eucharist was central to the life of the founder of her religious order - Blessed Josaphata. The Provincial Superior of the Basilian monks, Fr. Gabriel Haber, OSBM, also spoke about the significance of the Holy Eucharist to their great martyr - Saint Josaphat. On the 3rd day we honoured and prayed for our parish founders and pioneers and for all our deceased loved ones at a Divine Liturgy and Panakhyda. This was followed by a fascinating presentation by Archeparchial Archivist Gloria Romaniuk about the saintly Fr. Philip Ruh, OMI and the building of our Parish's 2nd Church. Then, of course the truly inspirational Sunday Divine Liturgy with our Archbishop Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak and so many clergy and guests. This was followed by a gala dinner at which we celebrated our centenary with history, song and heartfelt fellowship. In fact that was also a highlight of each of the events, the abundance of good will, sharing, fellowship and, yes, great food and refreshments. **Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! for all YOU did - by volunteering, helping and praying - to make it a truly worthy and successful celebration!**

If we bask in the warmth of the wonderful celebrations (and rest a bit) for awhile, that's quite alright. It was a lot of work and there is a lot to ponder about - all that was said and done. We also want to look forward into the "2nd Century" of our parish and to think about that. What do we need to do to prepare the path for the next generation? 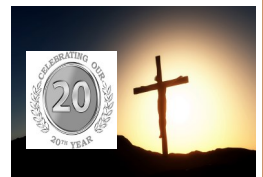
