

# Stay with Mary and the Holy Women, or at least, Stay with the Apostles...

Todav is a day of uncontainable joy! The Lord, as the prophecies of old foretold, enters the Holy City riding on a donkey's colt (Zachariah 9:9). The crowds are unprecedented! They spread branches and their garments that he would enter Jerusalem as a King! The religious leaders are indignant and ask Jesus to do something about the crowd. He tells them that even if He could quiet the ecstatic crowd, then the lifeless stones would cry out for joy! However... unbelievable things will happen in the next few days. These same crowds will be convinced that they should not rejoice, but demand Jesus' life!? He will be betrayed by one of the Apostles. He will be handed over to be beaten, tried, mocked and

sentenced to death because of individuals filled with unwarranted hatred on one hand, and on the other - those who should take a stand, instead betray their duty and beliefs out of fear and human respect. Who is left? Two small groups. One group consists of Mary, a couple of women who were saved by Jesus, and are joined by the youngest Apostle John (John 19:25). This group dares to follow the Mother of God along the way, because they can't imagine not being there for her and her Son. The other group is the Apostles. They run and hide. Perhaps peeking from time to time from afar, hidden terrified, dismayed among the crowd. The first group boldly stays with Jesus up to the heart-crushing end. The other group is afraid, but yet does not abandon the Lord or join the crowd. Both of these small groups remain loyal in their own way. Both groups dare to hold on, trust in God and hope - even if somewhat subconsciously - for the fulfilment of the promise of the Lord... (Luke 18:32-33). Let us stay the course of Passion Week with our Lord, prayerfully and physically... attending everything we can...


