THIS JULY 15... READY TO JOIN POPE FRANCIS!?

Папа Римський не дивиться телевізор і не користується інтернетом Папа Римський Франциск розповів, що вже майже 25 років не дивиться телевізор. Понтифік, який змінив звичні папські покої на скромний гостьовий будинок у Ватикані, в інтерв'ю аргентинський газеті сказав, що припинив дивитися телевізор увечері 15 липня 1990 року, давши обіцянку Діві Марії. Він також зізнався, що не користується інтернетом, а щоб бути в курсі світових подій, протягом десяти хвилин переглядає італійській газети. Крім того, він стежить за успіхами улюбленої аргентинської футбольної команди за допомогою своїх швейцарських гвардійців. (24tv.ua)

The Pope doesn't watch TV and doesn't access the internet (In fact, he hasn't wasted his time watching TV for almost 25 years!) The Holy Father, Pope Francis, who moved from the Papal Palace to the rather smaller guest building in the Vatican, recently revealed in an interview with an Argentinian newspaper that he stopped watching TV on the evening of July 15, 1990 as he made a promise to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He also revealed that he does not

use the internet, so to stay informed about world events he peruses the Italian newspapers for about 10 minutes. What about keeping track of how his beloved Argentinian Soccer Team is doing? He asks the Swiss Guards.

Can you imagine how our lives would change if we went off TV and the Internet!? So much time to read things of importance... to discuss real ideas... to spend time with people... to enjoy the world around us... to pray... to come to church... to start great and little projects for the benefit of society...

An average Canadian watches 4½ hours of TV a day! That's time you'll never get back. It could amount to 21 lost years (of waking hours) in a life time!

CNEWA calls on immediate support for Ukrainians displaced by war Ottawa, Ontario, May 25, 2015 – According to the United Nations, there are more than one million displaced people in Ukraine and another half a million seeking refuge in neighbouring countries. Despite a ceasefire, daily violence remains a constant, with the death toll increasing and more families fleeing to save their lives from oppressive pro-Kremlin forces. The fear that a major conflict will erupt at any moment is high.

"We received dramatic calls for help from the local Catholic church and its relief organization Caritas Ukraine that provides care for desperate families forced to escape the conflict zones of the Donetsk and Luhansk regions," said Carl Hétu, National Director of CNEWA Canada. "These people were already very poor, but now they've lost their homes, their church, their way of life and don't know if they will ever be able to go back."

"The Ukrainian people have gone through so much violence in their history and just when peace and hope seemed within their grasp, Russian aggression, once again, is trying to stop this dream from coming true," said Winnipeg's Ukrainian Catholic Metropolitan Archbishop Lawrence Huculak, who is a CNEWA Canada board member. "I invite the Canadian population to be generous in helping these frightened people in need of shelter and basic supplies who, above all, need to regain their dignity and hope in these turbulent times."

Through their actions of the past year, the Ukrainian people have taken their destiny in their own hands and made a commitment to build a truly democratic and inclusive country that embraces its ethnic and religious diversity, added Hétu. "However the military threat from Russia and pro-Russian forces is threatening the future of Ukraine and has caused great suffering to innocent families."
