had an army larger than expected. He needed to defeat that army and cross the Milvian Bridge into the heart of the city to win. Constantine saw in the sky before him a huge image of the Cross and the words that you see at the top (i.e. the Greek... the Latin and Ukrainian are later translations;-) Although he did not initially understand the vision, as he was yet a pagan, the Lord explained to him in a vision that he would know victory if he went to conquer with the Cross before him. Constantine did so

and not only won the battle and thus the whole empire, but he initiated changes that would revolutionize the world forever. He was converted to Christianity. He legalized the Church and not only stopped the terrible persecutions that had been the norm until then, but he himself built beautiful churches and monasteries and Christianity was able to flourish. It was the beginning of a glorious time of Evangelization filled with faith, hope, love and progress.

This week, as we venerate the Holy Cross upon which our Lord Jesus allowed Himself to be sacrificed for our salvation, let us also pray and reflect on how relevant that message to Constantine is for us today. It is only by the Cross that we have come to know salvation. It is only by the Gospel teaching of Christ and His Church that peace and enlightenment will come into the world. In our day, it is only by the power of the Christ's Cross that we will overcome the tragedies that threaten our society and our world. The odds against the Church at times seem overwhelming, but if we have the courage to hold up the Cross in our lives and promote all that it stands for... Truth, Faith, Sacrifice, a countercultural lifestyle, and conviction that there is salvation only in Christ Jesus... victory will be ours...




