

It was a popular question that, of course, was meant to wake us up to Christian thing. "What would Jesus do?" Well, unfortunately in our relativistic culture we sometimes interpret ourselves as to what Jesus, the only begotten Son of the only God would've, kind of done... maybe... Actually what Jesus would do is not as vague as we have come to believe in our day. Jesus' Gospel message is very clear about love of God and neighbour and about love and sacrifice. The teaching of the Church of Christ—has been very clear and consistent over 2000 years and is always renewed and expressed in modern terms and according to the need of the day. Why we ask ourselves the question "WWJD?" is because we either forget, or we never really learned or we want to see if there might not be an "easier" way to interpret what we know is probably the Truth. You know... all of the above reasons are understandable. When we don't have to deal with issues, we don't give them much or any thought. But when they come up—we have an obligation not to form our own opinion, but find the Truth of the matter. The Bishops have acknowledged that one of the biggest reasons for the marriage and family crisis today is because Catechism for the last 40 years has been pretty dismal and many people just don't know their faith. Well, do we sit and cry about it? No we start to seek out material and learn. And as for the hope that we can get an "easy way out" of a challenging situation is simply the wrong attitude to begin with. The challenge of the Catholic Faith isn't something to flee, but embrace and share - because it is the only source of lasting satisfaction, peace and joy to the world and life eternal (John 6:47-68).
