TODAY THE BISHOPS RETURN HOME... But what is the result of their three-week Synod at the Vatican? They spoke about the many challenges that families and marriages face today.... high divorce rates, unblessed (*i.e. 'irregular'*) marriages, need of greater support for marriages and families on the part of society and the Church, unchristian and unnatural relationships, need for greater understanding of the true meaning and purpose of Catholic Marriage and Family, etc... Now, Pope Francis, with the assistance of a team of bishops and others, will put together a concluding teaching document known as an "exhortation" in which he will present a new direction for the Church for our day - for us Catholics - in the world in which we find ourselves today. Some of the message will probably present Catholic teaching on marriage and family in a clearer more simple way for us to more easily understand. Some of the text may include new streamlined procedures with regard to marriage, reconciliation and forgiveness and new life. Part of the exhortation may also pose new challenges for us as a Catholic Church to meet the world around us and share the Gospel with all people as Christ commanded us to do some 2000 years ago. For our part, we must certainly pray for the married people and all families in our parish and among our friends and relatives. We must delve more deeply into Catholic teaching on marriage and family. And, when Pope Francis shares the conclusion of the Synod with us - presented in the light of his role as *supreme teacher and pastor* of the Church - we want to turn everything else off and set everything else aside and read and study this document. It will propose answers and guidance and it will affect our lives for years to come. There will be little else more important in our day...
