What in the world is happening!?

There is quite a bit happening in our global and local society at present and as Christians we need to assess everything through the eyes of our Catholic Faith - both personal and dogmatic. Aside from many cultural shifts already promoted and implemented in our society, our federal government will soon enact legislation about 'physician-assisted death'. Many social and moral issues are being raised in the context of the presidential election campaign now underway in the US (our neighbours that have a lot more influence on our public opinion than we would like to admit). We will soon be voting in a provincial election - besides political *pundits* telling us what the issues are... what do **we** feel are the most important issues that will influence our vote? Pope Francis and Russian Patriarch Kyrill recently met. They discussed our Ukrainian Catholic Church. Why? What does it mean for us? Terrible wars are being visited upon the Christians of Syria, Ukraine and Iraq. Thousands have died and continue to die. We need to know the issues and truth behind these crises. Climate Change - what is an authentic Catholic response? Pope Francis wrote a whole encyclical on this. What are we to do? Islam is growing, as Christianity - at least in the western world - seems to be dwindling. Again, what does this tell us and what are we to do? 2000 years ago, God in the person of Jesus Christ gave us a mandate to go and change the world, to bring the light of the Gospel to all corners of the earth. This mandate has never changed... maybe we have...and that is part of the reason why we live in the present world. Lent is a time to reflect on our life in Christ. An honest reflection. Will we just let the world happen around us, or will we do our part in influencing the world for good?
