

Feast of Christ, Lover of Mankind

Abortion, Euthanasia (physician-facilitated death for the ill, elderly, handicapped, socially burdensome, or otherwise deemed undesirable for various reasons) were once considered reprehensible crimes against humanity promoted by heartless totalitarian regimes. Furthermore, various lifestyles which only yesterday were generally acknowledged as unarguably immoral, irrational or both are now being presented as something that must be accepted and approved. With bewildering speed this is all being thrust upon society as an irrevocable "done deal". Two serious questions arise from this social development. One is that since to followers of Christ, such social developments can never be acceptable - even if deemed "legal"... what will be the consequence for Christians? The other question is: how is it that such developments are being ushered in to our daily lives with so little uproar (even with obvious complacency) on the part of active Church-going Christians? Perhaps it is the ideology of unquestioning tolerance that we have gleaned over the years from our mass media, education and from other ways that our attitudes are formed. That's a whole discussion in itself. However, regardless of "why?", we, as Catholics do need to act. We need to inform ourselves. We need to raise our voices in protest of what is bad and in support of what is good. But we need to get with it not only on the information and legislative front... we need to re-Christianize our mentality with regard to the people around us... the elderly, the infirm and the handicapped. We need to stop fearing age, illness, suffering or death. These are all inevitable. They are part of life. What we need to do is learn to reach out again to those in need those that are confused and afraid. We need to let those in need know that they have support, that they have a friend that will journey with them.
