The Servant of God **BLESSED LAURENTIA** (Harasymiv, SSJ) was born on 31 September 1911 in the village of Rudnyky, Ukraine. In 1931 she entered the Sisters of St Joseph. In 1951, she was arrested by agents of the KGB (NKVD) and sent to Boryslav. She was exiled to Tomsk, Siberia. As she was in poor health, she was relocated to the village of Harsk, Tomsk, and was forced to share a room with and attend to a paralysed man because nobody else wanted to be near a tuberculosis-infected tenant. She patiently endured sub-human conditions and continued to pray much and did much demanding manual labour. Blessed Laurentia finally died on **28 Aug** 1952 in Siberian exile in the village of Kharsk, Tomsk region. *Blessed Laurentia, pray for us!*

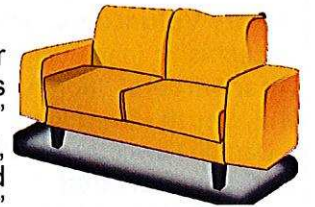

## POPE FRANCIS ASKS CATHOLIC YOUTH TO TAKE HOLD OF THEIR FUTURE, BECAUSE OTHERS ARE DOING IT FOR THEM

"The times we live in do not call for young 'couch potatoes' but for young people with shoes, or better yet, laced up boots. It only takes players on the first string, and it has no room for bench-warmers," Pope Francis said. Talking to young people in Krakow, Poland, where they were participating in a week-long rally called World Youth Day, the Pope warned them against the "sofa-happiness," calling it the most **"harmful and insidious form of paralysis."**



A sofa, he said, that "makes us feel comfortable, calm, safe," away from any kind of pain or fear, spending hours playing video games or in front of a computer screen. He said it's a dangerous paralysis because as "we start to nod off" **other people**, "more alert" but **"not necessarily better, decide our future for us."** For many people, Pope Francis warned, it's better to have drowsy, tone-deaf and dull kids who confuse happiness with a sofa. "For many people, that is more convenient than having young people who are **alert and searching, trying to respond to God's dream** and to all the restlessness present in the human heart," the pope said, adding that they hadn't come into this world to "vegetate, to take it easy" but to **"leave a mark."**
