

A MONTH TO HONOUR MARY THE MOTHER OF GOD

For centuries, the Month of October has been commemorated by Catholics around the world as the "Month of the Holy Rosary". This is, in part, because of an extraordinary event that took place 1571 when the Turkish takeover of Europe was a real threat. A naval battle at Lepanto would be decisive in the Turkish conquest. The Turks had a huge navy ready for attack. The European forces were by far inferior. Pope St. Pius V, called upon Europe to pray

the Rosary on the eve of the seemingly hopeless battle. If you can imagine the navy crews of the 200 vessels of the European "League" and many other countless people throughout Europe were fervently praying the Rosary during the time leading to battle. Well, as the terrible battle came to a close a reported 13 Turkish ships sailed away and Europe was saved. The Pope declared the Feast on October 7th and it slowly spread throughout the world. This feast is not actually commemorated in our Church. However, we begin our month with the wonderfully reassuring feast of the **Protection of the Mother of God**. We are reminded of how Mary intercedes for us before her Son, Jesus, for all those who turn to her in prayer and trust. One famous occurrence took place at the Monastery complex at **Pochaiv** in Ukraine, where the faithful were again spared from a Turkish-Tatar attack. We honour Mary this month through the Rosary and remember her promises at Fatima.
