Today we celebrate the feast of the "naming" or "Circumcision" of our Lord Jesus, remembering that event when Mary and Joseph brought Him to the temple on the eighth day according to the Law of Moses (Luke 2:21) - showing that the Saviour wanted to subject Himself to the laws and customs like everyone else and to show that He was fully "a descendant of Abraham". We also celebrate the feast of **St. Basil the Great** today - one of the great "Fathers" of the Church who helped explain so much about the Faith in the early centuries of the Church. St. Basil also wrote rules for monastic life that are used to this very day throughout the world. However, in the context of our secular lives and the culture in which we presently live, today we also celebrate the beginning of the New Year...

The year before us will be as great as WE make it. Yes, we do find ourselves in particular situations that we strive to make the best of. Life, as well as choices - made by others **and by us** - have dealt us a certain hand that we now have to play wisely if we are to 'win'. However, as people of faith who have seen the amazing grace of God at work so many times, **we also know** that - if we ask sincerely in **prayer** - our loving Lord can transform all situations (even by miraculous means!). Today is a feast day (as well as a Day of the Lord, Sunday) but it is also a good opportunity for us to think

about the year ahead and about how we would like it to be. It is a good opportunity for us to ask the Lord in prayer for His blessing and grace for our lives to become even better. We especially ask the Lord to grant us whatever He knows is best for us (even if it's not that easy right now for us to see His plan). BUT... we also want to make some concrete goals and plans for ourselves and those around us. We want to **think big** as Ukrainian Catholics and quite simply "go for it!". We want to place our plans in God's hands and ask Him to tweak them and to guide us to great success as His disciples. It is doable! **We need to make the choice** to move...

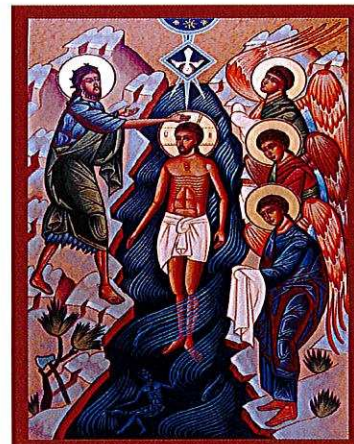
