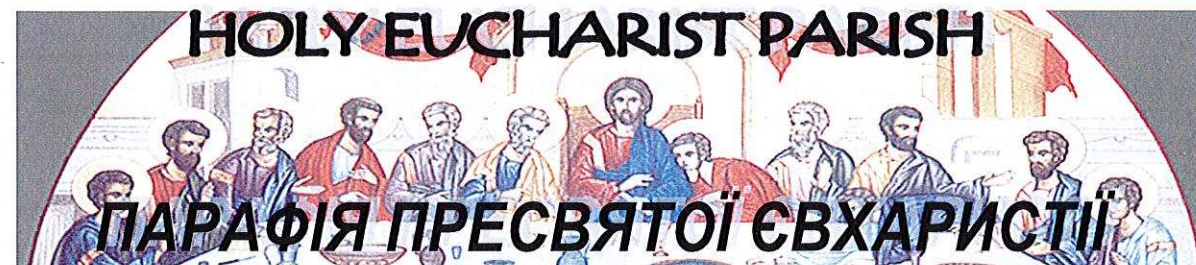

Fifth Sunday of LENT

2 KBITEHb 2017 p.

**Mary of Egypt**, who we venerate today as an example of repentance and of giving ourselves totally to our Lord... was born probably about 344; died about 421. When she was only 12, Mary left her home went to the big city of Alexandria, where she soon got in with the wrong crowd and eventually started to live an immoral life 'on the streets' and that is how she lived for 17 years. One day, she was able to join a pilgrimage to the Holy Land, and she went just for a good time. When she arrived in Jerusalem she, alas, persisted in her shameless life. However, when the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross came along, she saw the huge crowds making their way to the church that held the great relic of the true Cross (like the one we have here at our church!) and she went to see if she might not get some money out of the opportunity. Everyone was going inside so she decided to go in and see what main "attraction". She could not get in the door. Not because of the crowd or because any person stopped her... she was blocked by a force that she could not see, but was very real. She tried a few times to enter. But she could not. She then realized what it was all about. The Lord wanted her to understand that she could not go on living a sinful life. She not only felt ashamed, but she repented right there. She cried and asked God's forgiveness. A statue of Mary the Mother of God caught the corner of her eye. She turned to the all pure Virgin to intercede for her. She begged Mary to obtain from her Son, Jesus, forgiveness and the possibility to enter the church to venerate the relic. She was able to do so. Mary of Egypt then heard an internal voice that encouraged her to go out into the desert. She dwelt in the desert for some 47 years living on herbs and prayer. Toward the end of her life, she met a monk in the desert who gave her Holy Communion. She died after that. We know of the incredible story of her life and her conversion and eventual life of angelic holiness (*this is only a brief summary*) because of the monk, Zosimus.
