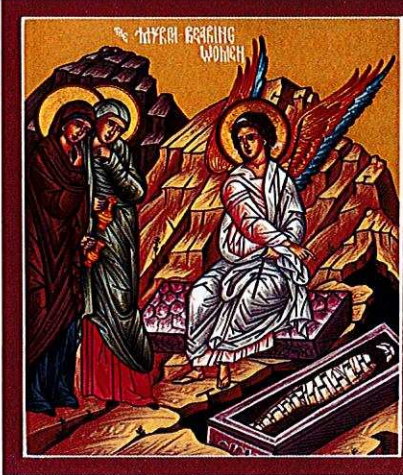

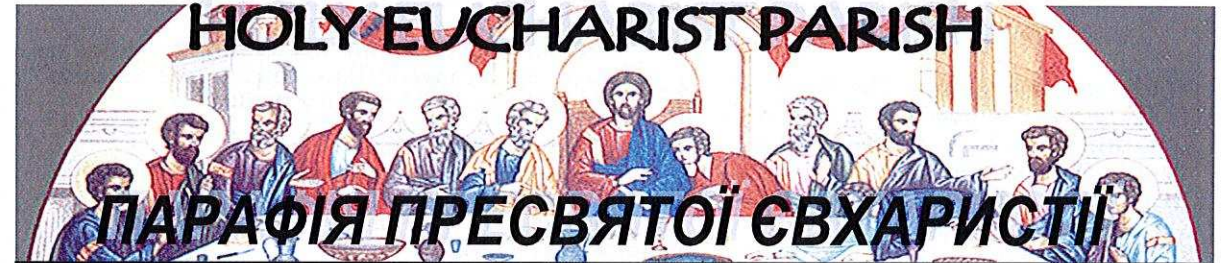

the **myrrh-bearing women** Today we once again travel back in mind and soul to that "first day of the week" when the faithful women who loved the Lord and His Gospel message gathered up everything that they needed and left the house early in the morning to complete the basics funeral traditions in order that Jesus would at least have a decent burial. Have you ever made an early morning trip? Or gone out for a walk or a jog before dawn? The air is cool and crisp and all is quiet except for the odd person hurrying off to work or maybe coming home after a night-shift. Its just you and those with you moving through the streets. In this case a small group of women making their way to the edge of the city to the place where Jesus (the Messiah! Not!? The Lord! Not!?) was hastily buried just three days ago. Hastily, because the religious regulations demanded it. Hastily, so that no one else would be able to abuse Him any more. But what is this!? The tomb is open! The tomb is empty!
