Today we join the Basilian Fathers in celebrating the 400th Anniversary of the founding or reformation of their monastic community - the ORDER OF SAINT BASIL THE GREAT OF

ST. JOSAPHAT. It was in 1617 that St. Josaphat (whose feast is also exactly today!) who was a monk himself of the Rule of St. Basil, collaborated with the holy Metropolitan Joseph Veliamyn Rutsky to revitalize the monastic life in Belarus and Ukraine. They united 5 major monasteries into one community to live by a single rule of life and under one superior. This was pretty radical for the time, but it worked! They were able to

combine their resources - material, intellectual, skills and spirituality! They did amazing things in the history of the Church. Their missionary spirit is what helped spread the Church throughout Canada. They arrived in with the first Ukrainian immigrants and Why do they served them tirelessly throughout the west and in Eastern Canada as well.
