WEEK UNTIL CHRISTMAS!

It is a peaceful celebration of the coming of Christ the Son of God - i.e. our one and only Saviour - into the world. It is a time that gives us solid hope and sets everything into perspective. No matter what struggles or worries or hurt we may be experiencing in life... Christmas is a powerful reminder that, "Hey! The Lord is coming! We need to very simply turn to Him, give our lives and concerns to Him, follow His path in life [i.e. the Gospel and the Teaching of His Church] and everything will come together!"
