



Pope Francis has written a new exhortation on Holiness for our world. He gave it the title: "Rejoice and be Glad"! Check the Archeparchial website to read the text! In it he writes about, "certain aspects of the call to holiness that I hope will prove especially meaningful", in the form of "five great expressions of love for God and neighbour that I consider of particular importance in the light of certain dangers and limitations present in today's culture.". These aspects are: 1) Perseverance, patience and meekness (those who keep silent to preserve harmony, who prefer to praise others rather than boast about themselves, who choose the less welcome tasks, bearing an injustice so as to offer it to the Lord); 2) Joy and a sense of humour (Saints are joyful and full of good humour. They radiate a positive and hopeful spirit); 3) Boldness and passion (the Church needs passionate missionaries, enthusiastic about sharing true life); 4) In community (Growth in holiness is a journey of living and working with others) and 5) In constant prayer (Trust-filled prayer of any length is a response of a heart open to encountering God face to face)
