The Holy Fathers of Nicaea

It's here again. Mother's Day! It has been around so long and yet we always have something to say... something to give.... some new poem... some new card... some slightly different way that we tell our mothers that we love them and appreciate them. Everyone expresses it slightly differently. It means something slightly different to every mother. We are all unique. Our mothers are all unique. One thing the same is that our mothers deserve love and respect for the very reason that they brought us into the world and cared for us as best they could regardless of the circumstances dealt to them. The love and sacrifice that mothers make is legendary. The quiet pain and heartbreaks that they experience throughout life - we will never fully understand until, perhaps, the next life. Why do we love and honour our Mothers? Yes, above all, because God has so commanded through Moses on Mount Sanai (Deuteronomy 5:16) and when teaching a young man during the earthly sojourn of Jesus the Christ (Matthew 19:19) even in very strong words (Matthew 15:4). But also because it is natural and logical that we would return the love of one who never stops loving us from the moment of our birth. Oh, we may break her heart. We may disappoint her. She may even go through difficult times. But a mother's love for her child - for all her children - is never washed away.

Now, there comes a time when we must part with our mothers at a time according to the will of the Lord. Our mothers, one day, will be called home.... called to go before us (usually, but not always) to prepare a place for us at the "banquet table" of the Lord. Our love for them is not diminished. We pray for them. We ask them to pray for us. They do. We use the love and wisdom that they passed on to us to fulfill lives that are worthy of them and beyond! God, love our mothers and watch over them and walk with them. Today we hug them, physically, if they are with us, or we hug them with our souls and with a prayer. We can give them candy or chocolates or do the dishes today. But let us also take a moment to just rejoice that the Lord blessed us with such a person in our lives and let us commend them to the Lord.


