When the truth just won't do...

Sometimes it is necessary for an idea or some information to be repeated several times before we "get it". That is why as students we read and reread the material a few times so that we understand the concepts and let them "sink in". That is why we need to hear things a few times before we fully appreciate their meaning and importance. Some experts say that we really need to encounter information (hearing, seeing) seven times for it to fully be grasped and understood. It often takes time for ideas or concepts or skills to fully take root. That is why training and study can take several



months or years. All the information can be crammed into a year (or less?), but time is needed to make the knowledge your own and to put the teachings and skills into practice. People like doctors, priests, teachers for example - study and train for six, seven or more years and then they engage in "ongoing education" to keep up with new developments and new skill-sets for their work. People don't think about it, but in ANY position in life, all of us need ongoing training and further knowledge as the months and years pass. If we neglect to do that ongoing training and learning... we fall behind and face challenges that we would handle much better if we kept looking ahead and preparing ourselves. But.... this brings us to one situation in today's Gospel. The blind man can see, but he is questioned over and over again by people who don't want to understand and don't want to believe. They don't like the idea that something happened and they weren't consulted. They don't like the person who did the great miracle. They don't like the attitude of the young man, etc. So... they refuse to understand and to accept the truth of the reality. A poor soul, blind from birth was given sight! They refuse to believe. They choose to live in ignorance and make up "fake news" rather than admit (and rejoice) that a new time of hope, truth, honesty and new life is upon them! The Lord tells us, "you will know the truth and the truth will set you free!" (if you want...)
