There are countless studies that tell us how important fathers are in the lives of every person - from childhood, on throughout adult life. Sometimes fathers are not around, because they are afraid of growing up and they run, or they become so goal-oriented that they put work, career and achievements before their family. Also, yes, fathers pass from this life and the Lord provides their children the grace of fatherhood in some other way, perhaps through other individuals. There are also countless quotes available that talk about how important and wonderful fathers are (or could/need to be). Some are witty, like that attributed to Mark Twain, *"When I was a boy of fourteen, my father was so ignorant I could hardly stand to have the old man around. But when I got to be twenty-one, I was astonished at how much he had learned in seven years."* (i.e. as Twain matured, he realized how wrong he was about his father) or from the perspective of a Father, *"Being a father has been, without a doubt, my greatest source of achievement, pride and inspiration. 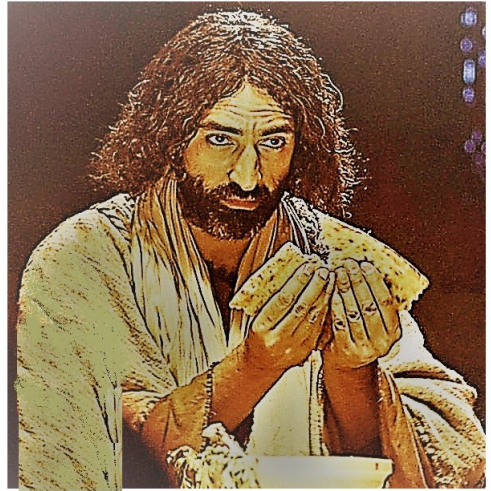

LITURGY INTENTIONS

There are really few gifts that one can offer anyone that would even compare to a Eucharistic Divine Liturgy for their intention. If we understand the awesome Sacrament, we realize that whole “gift” is Christ-God Himself “it is You Who offer and You Who are offered!”. That is why requesting that a Divine Liturgy be offered for someone is VERY special and to have a Divine Liturgy offered for you or a loved one is an encounter with God. Now, when there were more priests available (e.g. filled monasteries) then it was easy to “book” a Liturgy. However, in our day, it is not always that easy to get the day and time that one wants. However, on weekdays it is possible to have a Liturgy offered specifically for a particular intention (a person, a family, an event, a request, etc.). *[Although we want to always remember that Divine Liturgies are always public and anyone of the Faithful may attend and participate]* On Sundays and major feast-days, however, the parish priest is obliged to offer one Divine Liturgy for all the parishioners! Now, if there is more than one Divine Liturgy offered on such a day, then a second (and third) Liturgy may be offered for another requested intention. Now, this is also possible if there is more than one priest celebrating at the Altar at the Liturgy. How so? The main celebrant is offering “his” Divine Liturgy for the people, but then one of the concelebrating priests may offer “his” intention for a special request. He may or may not be able to announce the requested intention *aloud* during the Liturgy (depending on the circumstances), but whether he does or not – his intention for the Liturgy is for the request that he was given. Cards are available from the parish office to inform individuals that a Divine Liturgy was or will be offered at Holy Eucharist Church for them or their loved one. Can a Divine Liturgy be requested outside the regular Liturgy times? Yes, but that must be arranged with one of the local priests of the parish and that would depend on his availability and other conditions.

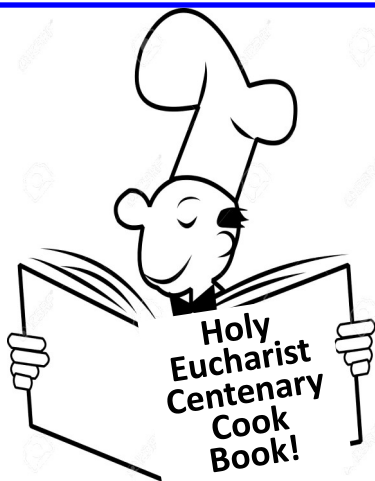

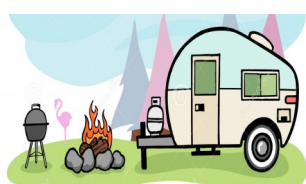
