THE UKRAINLAN SAINTS OF JULY...

- 2 Priest-Martyr Yakym (Joachim) Senkivskyj, OSBM [45-year-old Basilian Priest who was killed by the Communists in Drohobych, Ukraine 29 June 1941]
- 10 Venerable Anthony of the Caves [A monk that received monastic formation on Mount Athos, returned to Kyiv in Ukraine. Lived in a cave down by the river Dnipro. Eventually more joined him and the great Monastery of the Caves developed. He died 1037]
- 11 Blessed Olha Princess of Kyiv [The Grandmother of St. Volodymyr the Great. Died 11 July 969]
- 12 Theodore & John, Martyrs of Kyiv [This father and son were killed 12 July 978 because of their Christian Faith. Their courageous faith and willingness to die was an inspiration to St. Volodymyr]
- 15 St. Volodymyr the Great [He accepted the Faith and declared if for his people. Died 15 July 1015]
- 17 Venerable Martyr Sr. Tarsykia Matskiv, SSMI [killed by a Communist soldier at the Sisters Servants monastery in present day Chervonohrad, Ukraine. 17 July 1944]
- 18 Venerable John of the Caves "the longsuffering" [Struggled for 30 years in the Kyiv Monastery before achieving peace and perfection according to the Lord.]
- 24 Venerable Polycarp Archimandrite of the Caves Monastery [Became the abbot of the famous Kyiv Monastery and contributed to the formation of many holy monks. Died 24 July 1182]
- 26 Venerable Moses "the Hungarian" of Kyiv [His two brothers Ephaim and George are also saints. He was captured from Kyiv by invading Poles and bought as a slave by a noble woman who subjected him to unbelievable temptation and then horrific torture when he resisted. He was finally able to return, gravely harmed, back to Kyiv. He became a holy leader and miracle-worker in the Monastery. Regarded as a type of patron saint for those who are suffering temptation.



The Pope thanks the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Church (UGCC) for its witness to the unity of Christ's Church Pope Francis meets with His Beatitude Sviatoslav at the Vatican Wednesday, 04 July 2018,

His Beatitude Sviatoslav has told the Pope that the road travelled by the UGCC was a path of martyrdom, a "testimony of the unity that Christ's Church enjoyed in the First Millennium, at the time of the Baptism of Saint Volodymyr, and a particular witness of martyrs and confessors for Church unity, - in the 20th century." "Our Church's path of martyrdom consists in a recognition of the particular mission of the Successors of the Apostle Peter as visible servants of the unity of Christ's Church," the Head of the UGCC

declared in his conversation with the Holy Father.

The Holy Father also expressed his closeness to the Ukrainian nation which, as the victim of unjust aggression, is living through a painful period of its history. He assured His Beatitude that he constantly thought of and prayed for Ukraine. Pope Francis drew particular attention to the issue of Polish-Ukrainian reconciliation, especially this year when both nations are celebrating the centenary of their restoration of statehood, and the seventy-fifth anniversary of the Volvn Tragedy. He thanked His Beatitude Sviatoslay for the the book "Dialogue Heals Wounds," which the Pope considered to be an important step in healing old wounds, - in the relations between the two nations. The Pope supported the idea of the Roman Catholic Church and the Ukrainian Catholic Church, in Poland and Ukraine, issuing a joint pastoral letter, and declaring Pope Saint John Paul II patron saint of Ukrainian-Polish reconciliation.

His Beatitude assured the Holy Father that the UGCC will unite itself with him and with all the participants of the joint ecumenical act of prayer for peace in the Middle East, due to take place on 7 July in Bari (southern Italy). The Pope promised that, during this prayer, he will also remember Ukraine.

Pope Francis was in full agreement with His Beatitude's idea to organize, next year in Rome, a meeting of Eastern Catholic bishops of Europe (COCE). The Pope promised to participate at this gathering, of which the main theme will be "The Ecumenical Mission of the Eastern Catholic Churches of Europe Today." At the conclusion of the audience, the Father and Head of the UGCC presented Pope with the book "Persecuted for the Truth", published by the Ukrainian Catholic University, and asked for the Apostolic Blessing upon the Ukrainian nation. PARISHIONERS! In the interest of expanding our collective stewardship for our Parish - we are adding to our liturgical participation. We thank those who now accept taking turns **Reading**, **Greeting**, **Ushering**/Collecting, **assisting** at Holy Communion and **helping distribute** Holy Communion as well as the **Altar Servers** and the **Girls of Mary**. Now we are expanding to the services of **Sacristan** and **Acolyte**. If you are designated as a **SACRISTAN** (an "S" in front of your name above), **don't panic**. All it involves, for now, is that you come a bit earlier to **light the candles** before the Iconostas(2), on the Tetrapod(2), on the Prokomedinyk(2) & upon the Altar(14). After the Divine Liturgy, simply, respectfully, extinguish them all. **ACOLYTE** ("A"), for now, simply means lighting the **charcoal for the Censer** (kadylo) before the Divine Liturgy, placing it out in the Sanctuary and asking the presiding Priest if help will be needed during the Liturgy. He may ask that you remain near the Altar to pass the Kadylo when needed, and to lead the entrances (with the Gospel and with the Gifts) with a candle and open and close the "deacons' doors".
