#### A MID-SUMMER INVENTORY AND PLANNING

The summer is going fast, or slow, depending what you are doing. In Winnipeg we sometimes like to complain about winter... "it's so long!"... "it's so cold"... "it's so limiting", etc. And, depending on our experience at the time, the complaints may seem very justified. However, as the 'Preacher' wrote in the Book of Ecclesiastes... there is a season for everything. A season to plant, and another to harvest, a time to build and a time to tear down, a time to laugh and another to have a good cry. The trick is simply use the seasons (the times) as they come. Right now, for example, we have warm weather to get out anD walk for health and to just enjoy God's nature. The weather makes it easier for us to visit people like we can not do so easily in the winter. In the morning we wake up praising God and we join the faith community for the Eucharistic Liturgy. In the day we work and meet people and shop and read, etc. In the evening we gather with family and/or friends to pray and talk and discuss the faith and life. We play and laugh and just be together.

What we also want to do now when we can is do the work of the Lord, by experimenting with Evangelization... by getting out to people that we do know well or at all... and try sharing my faith with them. It will be trial and error, but we'll get it right sooner or later. Because, regardless of the Season, we want to be busy about our mandate as followers of Christ to grow in our Faith and share it with others. Like the Apostle Paul wrote in his second letter to Timothy (4:2) "preach the word, be urgent in season and out of season, convince, rebuke, and exhort, be unfailing in patience and in teaching". What St. Paul is saying is take advantage of a good opportunity to do whatever good you can, because the optimal conditions will pass and peoples' openness to hear the truth may change. Plant seeds while you can, because the opportunities to do so, may not always be easily available. The present summer months are the best!

In Constantinople and the Greek world grapes were placed on a table in the center of the temple and offered and blessed at the end of the Divine Liturgy and then partaken of by the faithful. Over time this blessing was extended as other first-fruits were brought to be offered and blessed.

**PARISHIONERS!** In the interest of expanding our collective stewardship for our Parish - we are adding to our liturgical participation. We thank those who now accept taking turns **Reading**, **Greeting**, **Ushering**/Collecting, **assisting** at Holy Communion and **helping distribute** Holy Communion as well as the **Altar Servers** and the **Girls of Mary**. Now we are expanding to the services of **Sacristan** and **Acolyte**. If you are designated as a **SACRISTAN** (an "S" in front of your name above), *don't panic*. All it involves, for now, is that you come a bit earlier to **light the candles** before the Iconostas(2), on the Tetrapod(2), on the Prokomedinyk(2) & upon the Altar(14). After the Divine Liturgy, simply, respectfully, extinguish them all. **ACOLYTE** ("A"), for now, simply means lighting the **charcoal for the Censer** (kadylo) before the Divine Liturgy, placing it out in the Sanctuary and asking the presiding Priest if help will be needed during the Liturgy. He may ask that you remain near the Altar to pass the Kadylo when needed, and to lead the entrances (with the Gospel and with the Gifts) with a candle and open and close the "deacons' doors".
