STEWARDSHIP {supervising or taking care of something} This is a term that we have heard fairly often throughout our life. It often takes upon itself a spiritual, community meaning that may or may not have a religious angle to it. We hear that we all are supposed to play a role in the stewardship of the environment, as we all are stewards of the world around us. In this case it means that if we all do our part by doing simple things... not littering, not 'trashing' nature and water and the air around us - we will have a better, fresher world in which to live and pass on to the next generation (this "passing on" is an important thought...). We also show stewardship in our homes, schools and places of work, by all taking an interest in their maintenance. We don't break things or we get them fixed if we do. We don't abuse furniture and other facilities so that they remain clean and in good shape for years. [In taking a flight recently, I noticed a sign above the sink in the washroom "As a courtesy to the next passenger may we suggest you use towel to wipe off the wash basin". Wow, excellent little example of stewardship. Doing something with a thought for others.] Another aspect of stewardship is "voluntarily" doing something for the common good. We have a number of dedicated volunteers in the parish and our thanks go out to them not only for the good work that they do, but also for their generosity of spirit! Parishes have always depended on volunteers and voluntary stewardship to keep the parish going and GROWING and fulfilling the mandate of the Lord. Yes, the "worker is worthy of his wage", that is just. However, when someone comes forward to offer their "time, talent and, yes, treasure" as the stewardship expression goes - that is very special and the Church is not only grateful, but would only know success because of the generous donations of time, talent and donations on the part of everyone in the parish community. One of the most wonderful experiences of Stewardship in our parish are the volunteers at the Sunday Divine Liturgy. We have had people helping with Holy Communion by attending to the clergy by holding the cloth and by being there for the Communicants that appreciate a bit of assistance. Also those that help to distribute Holy Communion. Then there are the Lectors! The Altar Servers! The Girls of Mary. And, as of late, we have parishioners appointed, quite randomly, to serve as Greeters/Ushers and as Sacristans. These are not complicated tasks. The explanation has been printed in the last number of bulletins, BUT the service to our parish is great! Thank you to those that have come forward. Please continue to do so. 


