"COME TO THE LIGHT.... COME TOGETHER"

A little effort here at Holy Eucharist Parish to effect larger change in attitude and practice.

As we see changes to our parish demographic and are mindful of our financial challenges (especially now that we want to start a renovation project!) we can do things that will make a difference. * The "Come to the Light. Come Together" initiative proposes *baby steps* that we all can make to help us all start to shift our attitude from "me and my needs" to "us and our needs" as a parish family. * "Me and my needs" are important and need to be taken care of, but the fascinating thing is that when we widen our outlook to consider "us and our needs" we find that we end up helping each other and... "my needs" are also addressed in the mix and "I" get insights and help that I didn't expect.

So, the first two initiatives are really quite simple and logical. First, we have a (fairly) big church building and it isn't always filled to capacity, so there's room for Parishioners to sit throughout the church. And second, we are able to cover our monthly energy bills throughout our three facilities. * However, these two things give us an opportunity.... **1.** Sitting together is a sign of togetherness and fellowship; it is practical and makes collaboration easier. At meals at home, we sit at one table – it's easier to serve and the family/guests can communicate. When we go to a restaurant or a concert or a movie, we don't scatter around all over the place, we sit together. Why? Easier to be served and easier to communicate with each other. We only shy away from sitting right beside strangers as not to infringe upon their privacy or compromise our own. Here in our parish church, however, we are always striving to be one "family" in Christ. (go to pg 5)

(continued from front cover) We want to sit around one table and invite those who may be sitting off at a distance to join the group nearer to the head of the table. When we come to church. the goal is to come right to the front! We can better hear and be heard. We can see better. We can better respond together **in unison** and help each other stay "on the same page". Imagine the positive change that would take effect in a parish where everyone made the effort to come up to the front... to participate fully in the Liturgy... easily finding the right page for special parts... better hearing and seeing everything... responding and singing in unison... etc. **["...with one voice and one heart we may glorify You..."]** Except for some parishioners that are experiencing considerable difficulty in walking, most will make their way to the front of the church at least once for Communion and perhaps again for myrovannya, Confession, etc. Why not come right to the front at the beginning of the service? Think about this. Pray about it and decide if you can see yourself breaking an old habit (which is not bad) and maybe coming to the front. Because there is also a practical reason.... **2.** In an effort to reduce the waste and cost incurred by the unnecessary and excessive use of lighting, we ask parishioners to renew the old rules of "You turned it on? Turn it off after you're done." "someone else forgot to turn it off? You turn it off". Also, rather than turning lights on all over the place we will use only the lights that are truly necessary for reading and seeing and for safety. Come to a church service or a meeting and want to see better? Come to where the lights are on! Its simply good stewardship.

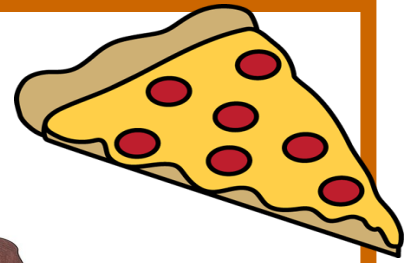
