As followers of Christ we continuously pray for peace. We normally don't seek to fight, we try to negotiate peace. When Jesus was being arrested in the garden of Gethsemane, he admonished His disciples that wanted to defend Him with sword, "Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?" This same Lord of ours suggested that we turn the other cheek when struck. Yet He also told soldiers to be honest and not bully people. Yet good people do go forward to become soldiers to defend their families, their countries, their friends from aggressors who do not want to know the Gospel message. They would conquer steal and oppress and impose a harsh and Godless life upon the subjugated peoples. Certainly our relatives and ancestors and some of us here today witnessed the horrors of heartless oppression under the totalitarian regimes of the Communist Soviet union from Lenin to Stalin up to the fall of the Iron Curtain and the Fascist armies of Hitler that wreaked destruction of land and its peoples. That is why people from our own parish here stepped forward to serve. They did not want to go and fight and certainly did not want to have to aim a rifle at anyone. Yet, when an aggressive enemy advanced, intent on death and destruction, some of our own parishioners stepped forward to say, "no, you may not do that." Today we remember them and thank them and, yes, honour them, because they fought that we would have the freedom to pray, work for the betterment of the world and serve the Lord and His People in so many ways. May they rest in peace and may their memory be eternal. **Вічна їм пам'ять!**
