A MONTH TO REMEMBER

During the Month of November, we take a few occasions on which to remember those who have completed the earthly journey. In Ukraine, surely due to influence from the Western Christians that remember their dead on “**All Souls Day**” on November 2nd, Ukrainian Catholics often make the visit to the cemeteries to light a candle and pray for deceased family members. The seminarians from St. Josaphat Pontifical Ukrainian Seminary in Rome also make a visit to the great **Campo Verano** cemetery to pray at the tombs of deceased Ukrainians that were buried (there is even a tomb for seminarians that died unexpectedly over the years!). Here in Canada, on **Remembrance Day**, we remember those that served in protecting our country and our allies. Next Sunday we will gather (**a half hour earlier**) at 9:30 for our Sunday Divine Liturgy during which we will remember our fellow parishioners and all Canadians that served in our military and are no longer with us. Every year on November 24th we also remember the great tragic genocide of the **Holodomor** during which over 7 million people were starved because a government wanted to punish them for not accepting the communist party line and for not falling into line... On November 24th, we will gather for a joint prayer at Winnipeg City Hall. We will also be hosting a prayer event here at our church in the evening (see the bulletin announcements). It is our tradition and so important to our life in Christ, to remember those that have died.... Because, of course, they are.... alive and we can and should pray for each other. Yes, they can and certainly do pray for us, and they too benefit greatly from our prayer. By prayer we ask our good Lord to bless the ones for who we pray and show His love and mercy to them, especially if perhaps they might not have merited such attention by their life alone. We remember... as we remember family, friends and relatives in our prayer now, we also want to remember them in our prayer when they leave this life.

The **Holodomor** (Ukrainian: Голодомór),^{[a][2]} (derived from морити голодом, "to kill by starvation")^{[3][4][5]} was a man-made famine in Soviet Ukraine in 1932 and 1933 that killed millions of Ukrainians. It is also known as the **Terror-Famine** and **Famine-Genocide in Ukraine**,^{[6][7][8]} and sometimes referred to as the **Great Famine**^[9] or **The Ukrainian Genocide of 1932–33**.^[10] It was part of the wider Soviet famine of 1932–33, which affected the major grain-producing areas of the country. During the Holodomor, millions of inhabitants of Ukraine, the majority of whom were ethnic Ukrainians, died of starvation in a peacetime catastrophe unprecedented in the history of Ukraine.^[11] Since 2006, the Holodomor has been recognized by Ukraine^[12] and 15 other countries as a genocide of the Ukrainian people carried out by the Soviet government.^[1]
