

## Welcome Metropolitan **Lawrence!** Welcome to all our **Parishioners** and **Guests!**

Today we continue to celebrate the many joyful feasts of this season. In our present Ukrainian Catholic reality - many of the feasts are doubled as both the "old" Julian Calendar and the "new" Gregorian Calendar are important to us one way or another. In fact, in this spirit, we find ourselves still in the Christmas season, but on the Sunday after the Theophany and Baptism of Our Lord in the Jordan and... on New Year's Eve - old calendar. Regardless of what calendar we lean toward more, we are still all beginning a new year of new beginnings and hope. By the grace of God we will accomplish many things as individuals, with our families and as a parish. An important element to this success is our constancy in prayer and our trust in our Lord. Pope Francis just this last week spoke about this in his "general audience" where thousands gather every week to see him and receive his blessing and hear his message... He said, "Dear brothers and sisters: In our continuing catechesis on the Lord's Prayer, we now consider Jesus' teaching on the need for perseverance in prayer. We see from the Gospels that Christ's entire life is steeped in prayer, born of his communion with the Father and the Holy Spirit who guides his every action. Jesus' constant prayer is seen above all in the events of his passion. At the Last Supper, he intercedes for Peter's perseverance in faith (cf. Lk 22:32), and his last words from the cross are a prayer for forgiveness and a confession of trust in the Father's will. When the disciples ask Jesus to show them how to pray, he gives them the words of the "Our Father". But he goes on to tell two parables that teach the need for constancy in prayer and unwavering trust that the Father will answer our petitions. As a good Father, God answers every prayer in his good time and according to his saving plan. Though the unfolding of that plan remains mysterious, we can be confident that, in the end, **ours is a loving Father who longs to fulfill the desire for happiness present in every human heart.**"

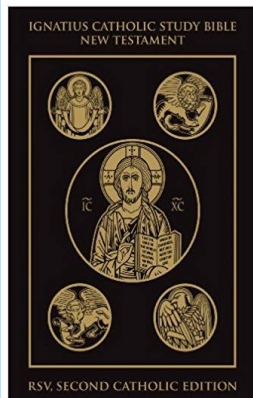
## Join our Bible Study and Adult Faith Exploration!

Monday evening **beginning at 6:30 PM** at the Parish Church Auditorium [lower level of the church]. All parishioners are invited!

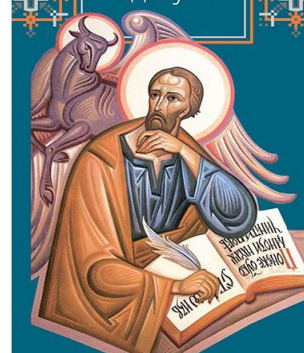

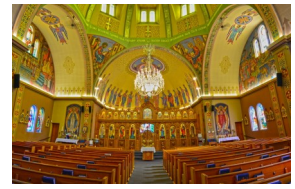
