

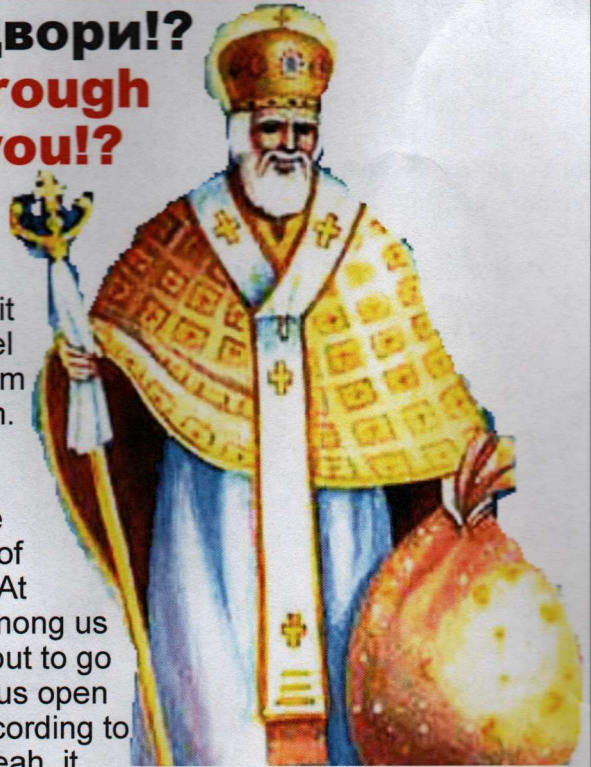

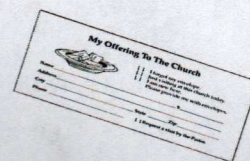

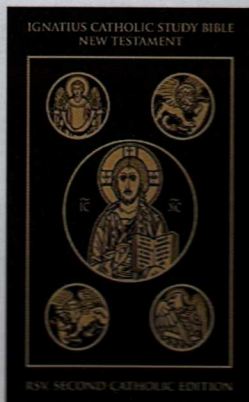

of the church]. All parishioners are invited!

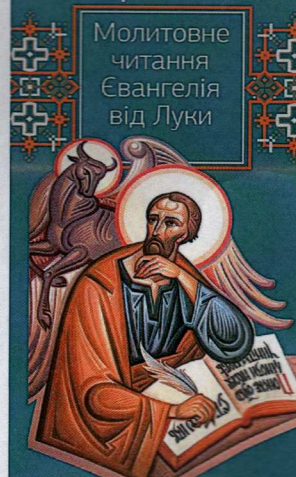


We are reflecting on Gospel of **St. Luke**. The basic text used
