“Come to me, all who are weary and are carrying a heavy load... I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me;... you will find rest for your souls” (Matthew 11:28ff)

Life sometimes seems to be pushing us forward like a tough drill sergeant in the army... or, even worse, like a heartless prison guard in some Soviet Gulag camp. Things move by so quickly. We hardly have time to collect our thoughts, to think, to plan, to grieve when needed, to work out questions in our mind about our faith, about family situations, and things like: what am I going to do now? What am I going to do this year, or with the years I have left? What is my position on that matter as a Catholic follower of Christ? Each day seems filled with routines that we designed for ourselves and can't relax until the 'things' are completed. We realize that we need to reassess our routines and reevaluate the things that we have considered priorities (i.e. are they really all that important?). There is a big help in life that we often overlook (or at least undervalue)... our parish church. We have such a beautiful place of worship (no exaggeration to say it's one of the most beautiful houses of worship in the province!) Churches, especially city churches, used to be open every day. You could step in during the day and spend some time with the Lord. Praying and thinking and LISTENING in the solitude of God's house. The outside noise of traffic and the world - just a hardly audible muffled sound. What a refreshing "recharge" it was. Well, the churches, alas, are no longer open all day, but ours is at least open for services every day. So many of us could just come to church every day to be with the Lord and to pray the Divine Liturgy and others services. Can you imagine having such personal access to the Lord Himself every day!? If more people understood the miracle that Jesus gives us every day, we'd have to build many more churches. Unfortunately many do not understand. Many of our churches remain very underused. Let it not be so with Holy Eucharist Parish.... Think about it! Arrange your life so that you can come every day! And when you do come... come right to the front to be with everyone! It is so much easier to hear and to pray and sing together and to stay - literally - on the same page (just look over to the book of the person beside you!). Think about it and give it a try! For the love of God, **come to church. Come right to the front** (you have as much right to the front pews as anyone else!) (besides you come up for Holy Communion anyway, right? so come up at the beginning and stay there! Come **under the light** (you'll see better)! **YOU WILL SEE A BIG DIFFERENCE IN YOUR LIFE!**

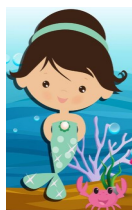

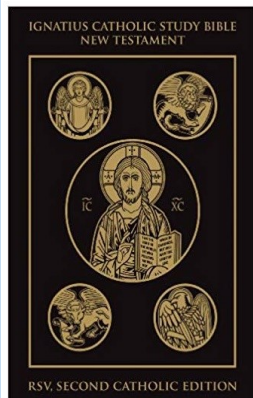

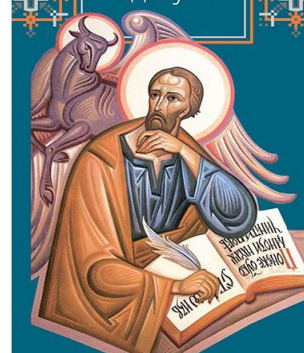

While attending the Tea, enjoy the Bake Room and Raffles.

Wives and mothers gave their husbands and sons clean clothes... even ironing them. Their men and sons would be on their way to church that day. They were going to church not for a regular service, but... to protect their church from a detachment of soldiers of the Russian Tsar. It would be tense, perhaps, and they knew it, some or all of them might even die. What had been happening in the last few years was that the some traitorous leaders of the Eastern Catholic jurisdictions (Belorus/Ukrainian), which were then within the territory of Tsar Nicholas I, started undermining the Church... saying that certain practices and customs were not properly Eastern and needed to be changed... this was plausible. [It was a planned and concerted effort to terminate the eastern or "Greek"-Catholic Church] But then they started saying that loyalty to Rome and the Catholic Church was exaggerated and wasn't that important. But then they said it was wrong and then... it was forbidden. That is when "push came to shove". The traitorous bishop started replacing priests that wouldn't give in with Russian Orthodox priests loyal to the Tsar. Well, today the soldiers were escorting a Tsarist priest to take over the parish church in **Pratulyn**. The 13 men and boys stood at the entrance to block the door. There were many other people around too. When ordered to give way, one, named Vincent Lewoniuk, said, "you can kill me, but you can't kill the Church!" He was shot on the spot. 13 were killed and others were wounded. They would not let their church and especially their faith be compromised. In a neighbouring village, **Drelov**, the parishioners tossed out the priest who wanted to give in. The soldiers came and some 21 died and hundreds of others severely beaten. The people prayed underground for some 30 years until things started to change again... this was not during Soviet years, it was in the 1870s...
