

"The liturgical tradition of the Church magnifies the most holy, most pure, most blessed and glorious Lady and God-bearing One as being "more honourable than the cherubim and more glorious than the seraphim. "The cherubim are the highest angelic order. The Church extols her "holy birth ... and her immaculate conception. By her purity and her being immaculate the Theotokos surpasses all visible and invisible creation. Nonetheless, at the same time, she belongs to the human race spread forth from Adam and gathered in the Son of God." Catechism of The Ukrainian Catholic Church "Christ our Pascha" p. 69.

With the decree Ineffabilis Deus [Ineffable God] (December 8, 1854), Pope Pius IX promulgated the dogma of the Immaculate Conception of the most-pure Virgin Mary. "The most blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of Almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin." (Denziger 2803; also Catechism of the Catholic Church, 491).



Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

On behalf of Board of Directors of Ukrainian Canadian Social Services Manitoba Branch I would like to extend our sincere gratitude to the Parish Pastor Most Rev. Dr. Michael Kwiatkowski and his Office Manager Ms. Carlene Deptuch, as well as Subdeacon Antin Sloboda and caretakers Paulina & Dale for letting us use the multipurpose hall during the days of November 19 and 20th for sorting and packing parcels and medical staff for needy people in war fighting Ukraine.

We manage to pack 30 parcels at our office at 235 McGregor Street with 20 wheelchairs, as well as walkers, canes, crutches and medical supplies. At 460 Munroe we manage to pack 36 parcels. Together we send 66 parcels to Ukraine. The weight of all the parcels exceed 1,632.50 kg.
