By next Sunday "Meatfare" we consume all meat products. Then by the following Sunday, "Cheesefare" we get rid of all dairy products. The plan is to spend Lent eating basic - albeit very healthy - cereals, breads, vegetables, fruits, fish and so much more. We also have any celebrations or parties or catch that particular

movie, tv series, etc. now before the fasting period begins. Many will have that last drink or finish their last pack of cigarettes before Lent begins (*just think of the \$ that will be saved!*). There are other Church-sanctioned and popular customs associated with Lent. They are all good - as long as the health of the infirm, the elderly and children aren't compromised. However, the real glory of Lent and the preparation before it - is on the spiritual plane with the very **salvation of our souls** in mind. Fasting and Prayer will help us greatly. In connection with that, however, we must make a decision in the depths of our soul to make the journey. We need to reconcile with all those around us who we may have a grudge or who may have a grudge against us. (we at least need to try). We need to reconcile ourselves with our Lord Jesus with a good sacramental Confession. We need to make a commitment to daily prayer - daily Eucharistic Liturgy would be ideal!. We need to seek the understanding and support of those around us during this period and we need to be understanding and supportive of those around us who will also be making the Lenten journey. We need think about this and plan now...

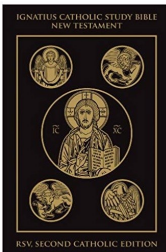

### HOLY EUCHARIST 100 ANNIVERSARY HISTORICAL BOOK

Good news! We are moving into the pre-final phase of the Centenary Book and **YOU** are invited to be an **IMPORTANT** part of it. Having parishioner photos taken by an outside photographer and printed in the book is a practice that is no longer around (due to various concerns—especially new social climate and new social MEDIA capabilities). Instead we are inviting families to do a short family write up and include a family photo or two. This is for families present and past.

The write up may be whatever you would like written about your family in the book - names, significant family dates, involvement in the parish and elsewhere, accomplishments, etc. It may be very short or with a **few** details. Photos may be any size but should be of good quality. Information should be submitted electronically, but some exceptions may be made for written or typed submissions. We will scan/crop the photo and help with the typing where needed. If you want the photo back, write your name, address and phone on the back. To help with the cost of printing the book, it will cost you \$50.00 for a **half** page (about 7x4.5 inches) or \$100.00 for a **full** page (about 7x9 inches).

Good news! If you place a write up, you will be given a **free copy** of the Holy Eucharist Historical Book (which will likely sell for more than \$25). Place your write up, photo and cheque payable to Holy Eucharist Parish in an envelope and place it with the Sunday collection or give it to the Parish Office. Deadline is **March 17**.

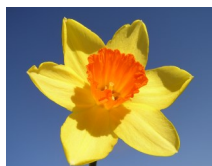
