the Salvation of souls...



Pope Francis' opening words at the summit.... "Dear Brothers, good morning! I wanted to consult you....so that together we might listen to the Holy Spirit and, in docility to his guidance, hear the cry of the little ones who plead for justice.... The holy People of God looks to us, and expects from us not simple and predictable condemnations, but concrete and effective measures to be undertaken. We need to be concrete.... We begin this process armed with faith and a spirit of great parrhesia [frank discussion], courage and concreteness.... Finally, I ask the Holy Spirit to sustain us... and to help us to turn this evil into an opportunity for awareness and purification. May the Virgin Mary enlighten us as we seek to heal the grave wounds that the scandal of

paedophilia has caused, both in the little ones and in believers. Thank you."

Much has been said during this past week... many witnesses, many testimonies, many protests, many apologies, many promises, many words... Perhaps, it was all to be expected. Perhaps it is all necessary. However, it will all be of little value unless we all turn our hearts and souls 100% back to the Lord. We have all been called by God and we have all been Baptized into Christ. Most of us have actually received the Lord-God in Holy Communion at a Eucharistic Liturgy.... and in fact plan to do so today! Let us make today different and the season of Lent different... let it be a time of true soul-searching and personal renewal for the good of the Church. The American President inspired his voters with a dream of making his country "great again". Perhaps a similar inspiration can guide us... that we would strive to rediscover the glory and joy of Catholic living and that we would strive to revive in our own souls and in our families and in our parish the pure love, peace, goodwill, kindness and courage in Faith that have always been the hallmarks of an honest life with Christ. Pray for your Church. Watch out for the young and innocent and the elderly and vulnerable. They'll know we are Christians by our love and truth.



HOLY EUCHARIST 100 ANNIVERSARY HISTORICAL BOOK Good news! We are moving into the pre-final phase of

the Centenary Book and YOU are invited to be an IMPORTANT part of it. The Book Committee is inviting families - IF THEY WOULD LIKE - to do a short family write up and include a family photo or two. This is for families present AND past. The write up may be whatever you would like written about your family in the book - names, significant family dates, involvement in the parish and elsewhere, accomplishments, etc. It may be very short or with a few details. OR... maybe just a favourite picture with a few details at the bottom. Photos may be any size but should be of good quality. It would make things SO MUCH EASIER if your information should is submitted electronically (not big into computers? Ask a granddaughter or neighbour) Yes, of course, exceptions will be made for written or typed submissions. We will scan/crop the photo and help with the typing where needed. To help with the cost of printing the book, it will cost you \$50.00 for a half page (about 7x4.5 inches) or \$100.00 for a full page (about 7x9 inches).
