My dear parents and grandparents; My brothers and sisters and other near relatives; My godparents; My spiritual and temporal benefactors; My friends and neighbors; All those for whom love or duty obliges me to pray; Those who have offended me; Those who have suffered disadvantage or harm through me; Those who are especially beloved by You; Those who will soon be released; Those who desire most to be united to You; Those who endure the greatest sufferings; Those whose release is most remote; Those who are least remembered; Those who are most deserving on account of their services to the Church; The rich, who now are the most destitute; The mighty, who now are powerless; The once spiritually blind, who now see their folly; The frivolous, who wasted their time in idleness; The poor, who did not seek the treasures of heaven; The lukewarm, who devoted little time to prayer; The lazy, who neglected to perform good works; Those of little faith, who neglected the frequent reception of the Sacraments; The habitual sinners, who owe their salvation only to a miracle of grace; Parents who failed to watch over their children; Superiors who were not solicitous for the salvation of those entrusted to them; Those who strove for worldly riches and pleasures; The worldly-minded, who failed to use their wealth and talents in the service of God; Those who witnessed the death of others, but would not think of their own; Those who did not prepare for the life hereafter; Those whose sentence is severe because of the great gifts entrusted to them; The popes, kings and rulers; The bishops and their counselors; My teachers and spiritual advisors; The deceased priests of this eparchy; All the priests and religious of the Catholic Church; The defenders of the holy faith; Those who died on the battlefield; Those who fought for their country; Those who were buried at sea; Those who died unexpectedly; Those who died of heart attacks; Those who suffered and died of cancer; Those who died suddenly in accidents; Those who died without the Sacraments or the last rites of the Church; Those who shall die within the next twenty-four hours; My own poor soul when I shall have to appear before Your judgment seat...grant eternal rest, O Lord, in a place of light, a place of verdure, and a place of tranquility, from which pain, sorrow and mourning have fled. As the good and loving God, forgive every sin of thought, word and deed... and make their memory everlasting...

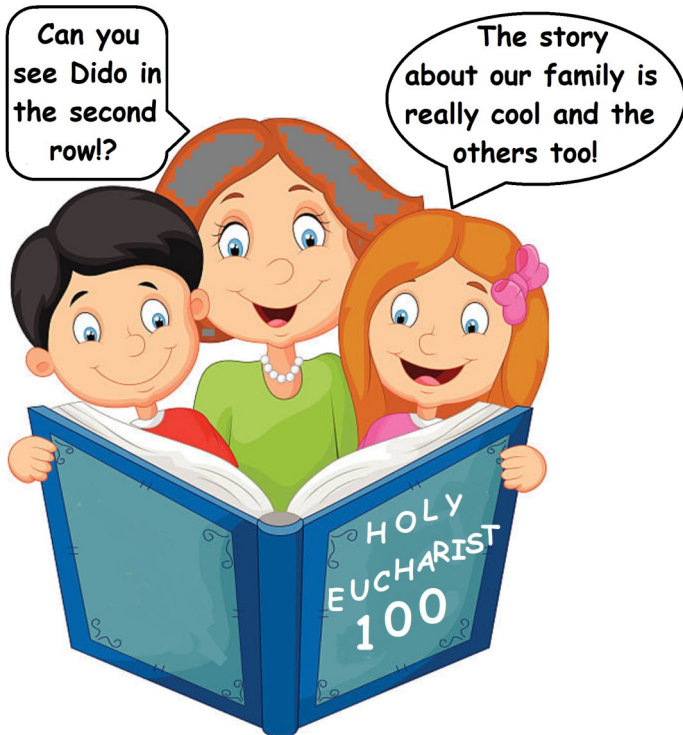
