How many hours have people spent on their knees praying fervently in this and the old church? Candles lit in hope and trust in the Lord's mercy and the intercession of the Mother of God and the many saints whose images adorn our walls and iconostas. How many people joyfully witnessed the baptism of a new child of God? How many

people watched in happiness as a young couple stood before God and His People to pledge their love for each other at their wedding and receive the blessing of Christ's priest? How many healing Confessions? How many conversions? How many tearfully bid farewell to loved ones at funerals and commended them to the Lord, trusting in His loving mercy, while contemplating their own mortality? How many Lenten missions were preached here? How many Easters were celebrated? A hundred years of grace multiplied by the hundreds of people that were parishioners and multiplied by the thousands of people that became connected with the parish as visitors or relatives of parishioners came in from time to time. THEN... from the other side... as we experience the potential power of



Lent, we also may do so in the context of our parish centenary, but looking **forward**. What foundation will we leave for the next generation and new members to build more upon. We always want to leave the place (or, ultimately this life) in a better state than we found it. Besides getting out of the parish what I need or think I need, what will I have contributed that will ensure that the parish will for another century or two? My life in the parish is really my life with Christ and my living out my role in His Church on a local level. Will I be helping to make the parish a stronger, safer place for future parishioners and my fellow parishioners today? The Church is the living body of Christ. This my, parish is my direct, personal connection with that body of Christ. Lent and my life in the parish is a key to being the best person that the Lord wants me to be. He will give me the grace and insights to become this person - *if I want Him to and if I work with Him*.



The People of Ukraine will be holding an election for their President **this Sunday - March 31**. The President may be chosen on that day or the decision may carry over to a second runoff election (if no candidate receives an absolute majority) on Palm Sunday April 21. There are some 39 candidates [Hey, Ukrainians are passionate about their politics and about their version of what is best. (ever attend a parish AGM?) There were actually some 52 candidates at one time, but some were weeded out. Some candidates are probably sponsored 'trolls' just hoping to take votes away from other more serious candidates. Some of the candidates might be oligarch millionaires that for the registration price of about \$100,000 can tell their grandchildren that they were "Presidential Candidates" back in 2019.) However, some of the candidates are well-known political figures that rose during the Orange Revolution of 2004 and have shown their interest in the political future of the country. They all have stories of glory and fraud surrounding them. The "fake news" and Russian influence muddies the waters so much so that it is hard to determine what is true and what is not. Yet... even with all the confusion and alleged dirt (real or otherwise) Ukrainians, like voters anywhere in the world, will have to decide what is best for their country at this time and which leader will uphold the values that they know are right for their country regardless of their background and imperfections. We pray that they choose rightly.
