

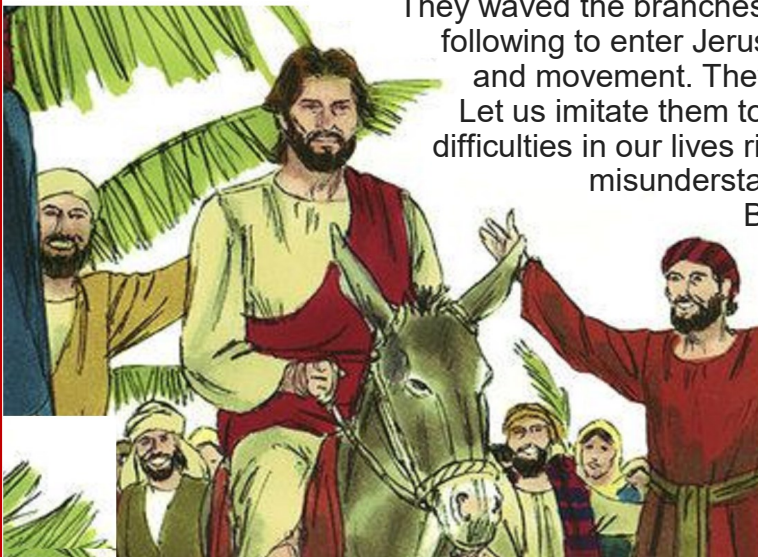

Today we celebrate with uncontainable joy the day of the Lord that is finally here! Jesus himself declares that if we don't shout in exultation, then the very stones will cry out! Even the Lord Himself, Who knows that in a few days the crowd will be manipulated to turn on him, allows his human nature to well up in him and rejoice with His People all around Him. Everyone is shouting, crying tears of joy that the long-prophesied and long-awaited coming of the Messiah has arrived! We too should rejoice today. Yes, the period of penitential and spiritually renewing fasting is not over (in fact we get much more intense about it in the week ahead). However, since we know the rest of the story, and we know that salvation is ours, we should allow ourselves to be happy today. We have such beautiful and inspiring and, yes, **fun!** traditions and we should enjoy them. Today we receive the aromatic pussy willows that represent the branches that the children of Israel snapped off trees.



They waved the branches, they laid them out on the road that Jesus was following to enter Jerusalem and they filled the scene with their colour and movement. They were filled with happiness and relief and awe.

Let us imitate them today. We may be facing various challenges and difficulties in our lives right now. Health issues, uncertainty, loneliness, misunderstandings, hesitation to forgive or be forgiven, etc.

But today is a day of hope. The Lord is truly with us. To be happy today and on days like today is rally an act of faith. It is saying, "Lord, You know me, my problems, my character, my weaknesses, I know that you love me and have come into the world for my salvation. Give me the joy today of one who is loved and one who has faith in You....
