Most people would agree that regardless of what is going on, we followers of Christ, should be sure that our voices are heard and that we do our best to influence the change in a positive way according to our beliefs and the Will of God as best as we can discern. However... as always - first and foremost - we need to prayerfully get our own act together. We need to find peace (Jn 14:27) and understanding about the issues and the teachings of our faith. We need to trust in God for our strength to take any kind of action - be it in word or deed. Sometimes we need to allow ourselves the time to retreat, pray, read, ask, talk about the issues and how we feel about living our faith in today's world. Retreating is allowed. Because after a retreat we can come back stronger and more certain than ever before. How about from today until Easter morning we 'retreat' as a parish and just pray together, talk, ask questions and allow the Lord to strengthen us in faith and in joy!?
