Samaritan Woman

Did you hear the one about the guy and the gal that met at the local well? Well, its quite the story. It turned out that the guy was no ordinary guy and the gal also turned out to be very extraordinary. You see the guy turned out to be the Messiah Who, furthermore, was truly the Son of God. He came to the well, to not only meet up with the women (although she never knew it), but to teach His Apostles a valuable lesson and to bring salvation to a whole town. The woman, on the other hand just came to the well at a time when no one else would (normally) be there. She just wanted to get some water and take it back home, where she had longstanding problems of her own to deal with. What transpired was amazing.... The man, Jesus, restored dignity to the woman by drawing out the honesty and hope that she had in the depth of her soul. She wasn't a "low life" (what a terrible expression) at all, but a child of God that was worthy enough to have God Himself speak with her and present her with a new life after her "confession" about her life situation. He promised her living water and she went back and brought out the whole town. In the mean time, Jesus takes time to use the whole incident to teach the Apostles that members of the new Church that would soon be established should strive to see every situation as a chance to Evangelize and share the faith... not to exclude people (unless they clearly choose to be excluded), but to hold out Salvation to all. We notice that the woman did not keep the life-changing moment with the Saviour nor the Salvation that she received to herself! No, she dropped her jar so that it wouldn't weigh her down and ran to share with the people in the village the amazing news about Jesus. She urged them to come out and not to miss the chance of meeting the Messiah! The woman became an "messenger" of the Gospel herself... she became an Apostle of the Good News! Re-read and think about today's Scripture readings and see what bits of information and messages you will discover....!

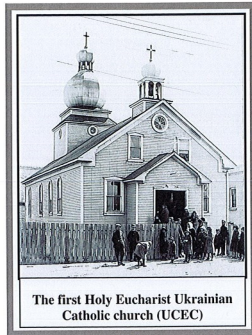

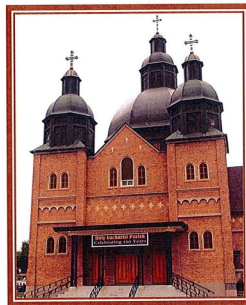

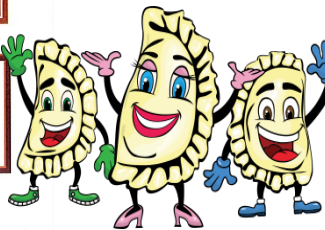
