Sunday of the Holy Fathers

Today we celebrate the gathering and accomplishments of what is known as the First Ecumenical Council that took place in the city of Nicaea in the year 325 AD. The Emperor Constantine was favourable to Christianity and, in fact, converted from his former pagan ways. As a man who loved his empire and grew to love the Church, he saw the benefit of the Gospel teaching for both the individual believer and for his entire realm. He did see, however, that the Christians that up to then had been brutally persecuted in so many ways, needed to come together and unite not only in spirit and theology, but publicly. He facilitated a safe and convenient environment for all Church leaders - the bishops, together with some other known theologians - and invited them to come to a conference at the heart of the empire. They could discuss important questions of the day as they relate to living the Gospel way of life and they could express - in a truly united way - important teachings for all Christians. It is called an ecumenical council, because it was open to the whole Church and intended to offer guidance and clarification for the whole world the members of the Church in particular. The "Fathers" of this council, under the

inspiration and guidance of the Holy Spirit, made decisions that affect the Church to this very day. In fact, one of the amazing things that they decided was the foundation for the profession of faith that most of us probably pray every day - the **Nicaean Creed** (on page 50/51 of our Divine Liturgy books). Today the Church honours the Fathers of that first of many Ecumenical Councils, for what they accomplished back then in 325, but also because: it was a strong sign that the Lord, as He promised, would truly watch over His Church and give clear guidance to us through His Bishops and the official teachings of His Church for all ages.
