



ICON OF THE PENTECOST

In two weeks from now we will be solemnly concluding celebrations of our parish centenary anniversary. One hundred years in existence – what a milestone! However, the feast of Pentecost that the Church celebrates this Sunday reminds us that our Catholic Church has been established over two thousand years ago with the Descent of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit which descended on the apostles and the Blessed Mother of God has been leading the Christian community ever since.

This time of the liturgical year – fifty days after Resurrection of Jesus we once again have a chance to replenish our souls with the blessings that the presence of the Holy Spirit brings.

As we prepare for our parish celebrations during the weekend of June 20th – 23rd, let us pray that the Holy Spirit continues leading our families and our church in each step and that we grow in the gifts that He has abundantly bestowed upon us. As our Catechism says: “The Holy Spirit bestows upon us a wealth of gifts. And though there is one Spirit, there are many gifts (see 1 Cor 12:4). “There is not a single gift that creation possesses that has not come from the Holy Spirit.” The Holy Spirit brings meaning and purpose to the history of human kind, directing it toward

Christ, the Divine Logos. The Holy Spirit is the Source and Giver of every human life. It is the Holy Spirit who creates humankind in the image of Christ, making it a living soul, his temple and the dwelling place of the Most Holy Trinity. (Catechism Christ our Pascha Paragraph 256).

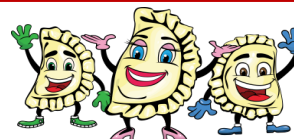

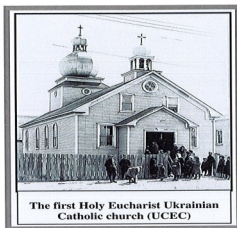
