Summer 'TO DO' List...

We are now well into summer and this is often a time when its easier to get outside and get out and about and to get things done more easily. We get to cleaning those eaves troughs... painting the house... fixing the fence. Here in the parish we also need to get things done while we have the weather and the time (and, yes, desire). We are fixing the front steps to the church.... we are planning to redo the parish centre roof before winter and months of snow.... where needed, the lines are repainted on the parking lot... the repair/replacement of the boiler and air-conditioner units in the church... the parish residence has had no significant updating or repairs for probably 15+ years... and a whole list of

smaller tasks and chores around the parish. We also want to take the time to plan well for the upcoming year! This means preparing (not just talking about) programs for Catechism, adult faith exploration, and outreach to our at-home (family home and nursing home) parishioners. We really must sit down and talk about our plan and action-method for building our fundraising groups (Bingo and Perogies) and growing the long-time organizations: UCWLC, UCBC and re -establishing the Knights (?) and HEY! or some kind of youth organization or group. We have great parishioners that are doing well with the Singing (under the leadership of Cantor Dave Hrehirchuk) and the basic sacristan duties, but we really need to look into developing those ministries too. (i.e. a sacristan that is more akin to a regular volunteer/employee that is there for EVERY liturgical service including funerals, etc... And we've often talked about a choir or singing group to explore new music and new songs, etc.). Preparing well for this coming year's Alpha gatherings.... Bible Study program... what does "Vibrant Parish" mean for us?... a serious parish planning session that would truly influence our goals and the things we will do and not do over the coming year. Then... after (or before) all those practical things, we want understand what the purpose of a parish is. What is the purpose and goal and mission of Christ's Church!? How can we get the grace for salvation that the Lord wants us to receive through our parish? How do we fulfill what we are called (supposed) to do as a parish of People of God!? What is our role as a parish and as individual parishioners in the Lord's desire to bring salvation to all people (all our fellow parishioners, all our neighbours and relatives, all people that may or may not be our personal friends)? Summer is a time to enjoy the Lord's beauty all around us. We also need to take some time to prepare for the year ahead of us. Let's talk. Let's share our ideas with each other, especially with parish leadership, in true Christian love and respect. We can really go far and accomplish many things that we will be pleased with and even proud of. Let's have hope and faith!
