

are scattered far and wide it is impossible to look over and see what page everyone is on. And it is difficult to help the person - maybe a visitor - over there who can't find the right page. Besides, isn't sitting far away a manifestation that we aren't striving to be as close as we should be in a parish community? If one feels that this isn't a big deal, well, then... just do it. If I'm always feeling like the taxcollector and need to be at the back of the church, well, maybe its time to get over it and get back with the Lord. He surely has great things for me to do. If I like to catch up on gossip in the back or in a corner, well, maybe its time to take that outside and when in church, come to the front. It's far to go to the front? Well, most come forward for Communion anyway, so why not just come at the beginning of the Lituray? Come to the front to be **close** to the **Lord** and be **together** with our brothers and sisters in the Faith. Do this for your parish! It is important. It will make a big difference. Let's come together, Let's come into the light! Beginning a new Century with hope and effort!
