"Lord, when did we see you sick or lonely and not come to you!?"..."Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of my brothers and sisters, you did not do for me." We have a number of parishioners that are housebound or in care homes. The number is slowly growing over time. This is natural. However, we want to understand that as they find themselves less and less able to visit our parish for Liturgies and festal events, they can not be as present as they would like. They very much appreciate having someone visit them from their parish. Why? Well, as we become a bit older and wiser we better appreciate how central our Faith is to our life and is the most important thing we have. To have someone from your faith community visit you is truly awesome and uplifting. WE MUST MAKE MORE TIME TO VISIT OUR FELLOW PARISHIONERS. This is not

an attempt to dump some guilt on us by any means. It is just that we often don't realize how thrilled and blessed the people in nursing homes (or shut-in their own home) are, when someone visits them. What do you do at a visit? Start by saying "hi" and the rest flows from there. Plan to tell them about what is happening in the parish, plan to say some prayers with them, ask them if they need anything (and then report back to the parish and/or to your parish organization). Ask them about their life and what's going on with them. As you walk through the corridors, say hi to everyone you meet. They too will be happy to have some human contact and a smile and maybe exchange a few words. If the person seems a bit despondent (or even upset) don't take it to heart. They might be out of practice or, yeah, maybe a bit miffed that no one has been around for a long time (or maybe not the

miffed that no one has been around for a long time (or maybe not the son or daughter that they wish would come by), but, believe it, they are happy and they want (need) to see you again. We must realize the great treasure that our presence brings - even if a brief "hi 'n bye" - when we decide to visit on a regular basis. In this culture of loneliness (and MAID) we need to make a better effort. **Think** about it and then **Act** on it.


