The LAST Supper - The Very First "Thanksgiving"



Imagine how Jesus felt during the Last Supper, knowing that in only a few hours he would be betrayed, denied and abandoned by his very own disciples. Knowing the pain he is about to endure and the sadness this would cause his Mother. Jesus did not run and hide, he did not stop the torture about to begin, rather he embraced it and why? For our Salvation.

14 When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. 15 And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. 16 For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God." 17 After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. 18 For I tell you I will not drink again from the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." 19 And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." 20 In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you." LUKE 22

At the Last Supper Jesus introduces us to the Eucharist. The word Eucharist is derived by the Greek noun "Eucharistia" which means "THANKSGIVING". During the Eucharist we are giving Thanks to Jesus for his ultimate sacrifice and his great love for us.

So this Thanksgiving when around the table with family and friends very much like Jesus was at the Last Supper, give thanks for all the miracles in your life, give thanks that we are loved unconditionally by Jesus.



Beginning in November 2013, Ukrainian citizens gathered at Independence Square in Kyiv to hold a series of spontaneous demonstrations calling for greater respect for human rights and closer integration with Europe. Government security forces responded with violence. By the end of the demonstrations in February 2014, 104 people were killed, 2,500 had been injured, and the government was changed. It became known as the Revolution of Dignity, and the wave of demonstrations were called "Euromaidan."
