

NEWS FROM THE SYNOD ON THE AMAZON... The Synod on the Amazon continues in Rome for another week. The purpose of the synod was to develop the best response on the part of the Church regarding the pastoral needs of the millions of people in the whole Amazon region of South America. In the course of the Synod all bishops have the chance to express their thoughts on the real problems and solutions. This past week one of the participants, a Bishop Wellington from Brazil, while addressing the **clergy shortage** problem, spoke very heartfelt words that inspired many. He said... "I don't see celibacy as the main problem [...] We've got other problems, and the main one that has to be addressed is our own lack of consistency, our infidelity and scandals, **our lack of holiness**, that sometimes represents an obstacle preventing other young people from following this path. We must allow people to hear the calling of Jesus, and sometimes because of our actions they're unable to do so. If I lead a holy life, I won't have a problem with ordained ministers, because **young people are looking for values and things they can believe in** and I can't believe that Jesus has lost his power of attraction. "sometimes there's not always a **missionary spirit**, a willingness to go to border areas and difficult areas." A different participant, a laywoman Yesica Patiachi Tayori spoke of concerns that have been echoed sometimes by our Ukrainian Catholic faithful here in Canada, "We're afraid of losing our languages, becoming extinct, being suffocated by development models that come from the outside. We ask the Holy Father [...] helping us to not become extinct, to respect our customs, traditions and languages, and our right to live in self-determination" (source: cruxnow.com)

Euromaidan

Beginning in November 2013, Ukrainian citizens gathered at Independence Square in Kyiv to hold a series of spontaneous demonstrations calling for greater respect for human rights and closer integration with Europe. Government security forces responded with violence. By the end of the demonstrations in February 2014, 104 people were killed, 2,500 had been injured, and the government was changed. It became known as the Revolution of Dignity, and the wave of demonstrations were called "Euromaidan."
