

**Much ado about the environment...** In recent years, there has been growing attention focused on "the environment". Every once in awhile the passion crescendos as it did this past week when the United Nations organized a "Climate Action Summit" that included a youth summit as well. Most of us probably heard about the youth rallies and protests in the U.S., but also around the world and here in our own city. What does this mean for us? First of all. ves. the earth was entrusted to us by the Lord of Creation, Who expects us to be **good stewards**. We can, in fact, become very disrespectful of God's gift of creation, if we don't watch ourselves. There is so much disposable packaging, bottles, and wasted food and things - for no good reason except "we can. we got the money, so who cares?" Well, most of us don't have that attitude. Most of us don't litter, or waste unnecessarily. We don't drive gas-guzzling cars and keep them idling as much as we can. No, we strive to respect the gift of this world as best we can. For the most part, we follow the recycling trends (and laws) of our day. However, we may want to survey our little worlds on a wider scale and see if we can in some way (realistic ways) be more conscious of what is going on how we might contribute toward the betterment of our world. However, we

also want to be wary of proposals that become overly extreme and sometimes have little or nothing to do with resolving the true problems. One proposal that keeps occurring is "if we eliminate or reduce the number of humans, then the environment will be safe". That smacks of hijacking a legitimate concern in order to promote other agendas like dangerous population control. It became painfully obvious when teens who have been educated about environmental issues that some 35% said that they would be afraid to bring children into this world were in fact asked to sign petitions that they wouldn't have children! We need to take a calm and faith-

rooted look at the issues and lead the way in proposing authentic and long-lasting solutions. Next Sunday, the Bishops begin meeting for a month-long synod to talk about what is an authentic Catholic response to environmental issues and other associated social issues. Keep them in your prayer that they will take the inspiration and led of the Holy Spirit in studying the issues and making decisions that will, in turn, inspire all of God's children to be more aware about and responsible toward God's world.

### His Beatitude Sviatoslav advised how to revive the Liturgy According to him, after the Second

According to him, after the Second Vatican Council in the Catholic Church and

in other communities, in particular the Protestant, there was a lot of discussion on this topic.

"There was a whole trend that began to treat the liturgy as a show. But then it became clear that the spectacle was a one-day fly. And the priest in such a liturgy-performance was supposed to act as a showman. And then they saw that such a revival of the Liturgy did not lead to a better experience of God," said the Primate.

"There is another way - to better prepare for the Liturgy, both for the priest and for the faithful," stressed the Head of the UGCC.

As an example, he mentioned a priest who initiated a truly liturgical reform in the Church. "He began to print texts for every mass, so that those who come to the temple had texts in front of their eyes and could participate in singing. Maybe we all should go that way," said the Bishop.

His Beatitude Sviatoslav gave two pieces of advice, which he received as a seminarian from his spiritual father

His Beatitude Sviatoslav gave two pieces of advice, which he received as a seminarian from his spiritual father Lubomyr Husar. "These tips have personally helped me a lot. The first thing he said - go to the Divine Services as a meeting. Not as a performance, but as a meeting ... We go to the Liturgy, not only to learn something there, to get some information, but to meet God. Moreover, to meet God Who wants to serve me. For Divine Liturgy is a moment when He descends from Heaven to serve me. Therefore, we call it the Service of God," convinces His Beatitude Sviatoslav.

And the second piece of advice: "Go to a meeting with God with this mood: 'God wants to say something to me, and I have to hear.' Believe me, if you go to the Service of God as to something new and different each time, God will speak to you. For the Lord God speaks. There are no two identical Divine Liturgies," says the spiritual leader of Ukrainians. "And when you go out of worship, ask yourself: 'What did God say to me today?' You will see that you will come out of such a meeting with a full heart and a special word that God says to you," says His Beatitude Sviatoslav.
