Yes, we can complain that the candidates might not be all that great in every riding. However, there is almost always the "lesser-evil" option. We might also say that "no matter from whom you vote, nothing is going to change". Again, that can be a defeatist attitude that just makes us give up without a fight. Maybe, we just have to take a hard look at society and ask ourselves what values are most needed. What are going to be the values that guide my vote this year? Promises of more money or less taxes? Let's not be naïve. Money is fleeting and taxes are going to be charged no matter who is power. Why? Because governments need money for all the things that we demand— better roads, super convenient health care, education, etc. How about taking a look at issues that are really starting to close in... religious freedom, the right to life, a moral uncorrupt society, etc. We want to find out which candidate and party platforms support and will fight for the values that are of paramount importance. What are crumbs of wealth when abortion continues to my brothers and sisters away and leave women and families scarred? What is wealth and convenience when MAID is robbing me of my mother and father way before their time? The next time a politician says that he is "fighting for you" we must ask, "and how is that? Just how are you fighting for me and my family and my people?". When a politician smiles and speaks boldly, we must ask what it is to smile about? And can he/she even deliver on the promises... even if they really wanted to? Perhaps its time to become involved in politics by 1. really getting to know the candidates in our riding and who is really worthy of our vote - regardless good looks or promises. The slogan of the provincial election was that your government and your province should reflect you and your values too! (that's a paraphrase). Your country should also reflect your culture, your values— yes your religious values also! We are who we are and we value our culture, our faith, our heritage. We should vote where our heart is. Otherwise, we are negating who we are and handing our future to other people who may not really care who we are or what is important to us...!

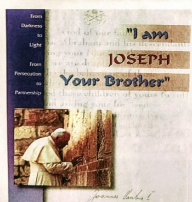
