# Lest we forget...

November is a month during which we intentionally or by historical circumstance, remember the deceased.... those that have "gone before us". In the tradition of the western (aka Roman) Catholic Church, November 2 is "All Souls Day" on which the Faithful throughout the world pray for the dead and often visit cemeteries to place candles and pray at the place where loved ones are buried. This has also become popular in Western Ukraine that has entire cemeteries lit up with candles for days. I also remember that the Ukrainian community in Rome also visited the Ukrainian gravesites at the massive Campo Verano cemetery on November 2, "because the rest of the locals were doing it on that day". However, this month we also remember the

millions of victims of the Holodomor Genocide in Ukraine "every 4th Saturday of November" (FYI -1:00 PM at City Hall on Nov. 23). Also, tomorrow, we will come together and join all Canadians and countries of the Commonwealth to pray for the many, many soldiers that died in the defence of our Country and for the freedom and dignity of many peoples in foreign lands. This Remembrance Day -Tomorrow - will be special this year. We are collaborating with the members of Prince Edward

Legion #81. We begin with a memorial Divine Liturgy at 9:30 AM, followed by a Panakhyda and two readings. Then we make our way across the street to our Parish Centre for a ceremony that begins at 10:45 AM. Representatives of all our organizations that have wreaths (UCBC, UCWLC, Youth, Seniors, KofC, Social, GofM, AS, etc.) will have the opportunity to lay them at the cenotaph at the parish centre. There will be light refreshments provided by the parish and served by our Seniors at the end of the ceremonies.
