WE HAVE BEGUN THE JOURNEY TO BETHLEHEM... Can these next days leading up to the Feast of the Nativity be any different than past years? Do we *want* them to be different? If so, then how can this time be different? Well, we have to make choices of things to keep and things that will be different... We want to keep all the good things about the journey to Christmas. Which have been.... 1. the **goodwill** among people that doesn't seem to be always evident throughout the year... 2. the **fellowship** when we get together in various ways as Christmas approaches. This comes about when we prepare **shoeboxes** for needy children... when we are having **singing practices** so that the Christmas services will be inspiring.... when we are **practicing our carols** so that at the 'Christmas season' we will bring joy to homes throughout the parish... when we have pre-Christmas **get-togethers**... when we prepare for the **St. Nicholas concert**... when we plan as a parish/organization/small-group as to how we can **reach out to parishioners** and others **who may need help and charity** during Christmas... However, we can make a **huge difference** this year if we strive to do some of the profoundly **essential** things that will really count... *abandon* those detrimental habits and relationships that keep me enslaved and bring me down.... and rather... *strengthen* (or renew if need be) our **marriages** and **family relationships**... strengthen (or establish for once and for all) my friendship with my one and only Saviour **Jesus Christ**... make a concrete move toward that good and wholesome dream or goal that we've always held back on... a goal to give my life and talents to the service of the Lord and His People, His Church! This "Pilipiwka/Advent" time can be so much more than the same-old/same-old that we've done in the past. It can be a time that will change our lives for the better. But we must place our trust in the Lord and move forward in hope - even if it is a *daunting* hope like that experienced by the Magi and even by Mary and Joseph. But they were inspired and they were determined to go forward into uncharted territory and trust in the calling that they had from the Lord. When they arrive in Bethlehem, so will we and we will share their joy... **IF we take the new, unknown, road less travelled...**
