for once and for all) my friendship with my one and only Saviour Jesus Christ... make a concrete move toward that good and wholesome dream or goal that we've always held back on... a goal to give my life and talents to the service of the Lord and His People, His Church! This "Pilipiwka/ Advent" time can be so much more than the same-old/same-old that we've done in the past. It can be a time that will change our lives for the better. But we must place our trust in the Lord and move

forward in hope - even if it is a *daunting* hope like that experienced by the Magi and even by Mary and Joseph. But they were inspired and they were determined to go forward into uncharted territory and trust in the calling that they had from the Lord. When they arrive in Bethlehem, so will we and we will share their joy... IF we take the new, unknown, road less travelled...
