

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

"So, You are a king then!?"

"For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth. Every one who is of the truth hears my voice" (Jn 18:37)



Jesus Christ began his public ministry with the proclamation: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news" (Mk1:15). The kingdom of God is personified in Jesus

Christ. One becomes a participant of the kingdom through faith in Christ and by holy Baptism: "The one who believes and is baptized will be saved; but the one who does not believe will be condemned" (Mk 16:16: see also Jn 3:5). We were created for the kingdom of God: "Whatsoever good things are sown in the human soul, these are the offspring of the kingdom of God and have been sown by God the Word, who was in the beginning with God." The kingdom of God is the Will of the Father, announced by the Son and fulfilled in the Holy Spirit. This "Blessed ... kingdom of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" will last "forever and ever." (Christ, our Pascha, 203)

Come, let us bow in worship before Christ the King, our God


